



Thank you for your interest in becoming a gas supplier on the National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (NFGDC) system. The following items may be required to be submitted by Suppliers that operate one or more market pools in NFGDC's Operating Territory. Additional form(s)/contract(s) may be required for aggregation services offered by NFGDC, dependent on the types of services desired. Information on NFGDC's Aggregation Services For Market Pool Operators can be obtained by contacting TSD-Billing at (716) 857-7432 or TSD-Billing@natfuel.com.

- ❖ **Market Pool / Production Pool Request Form**
- used to create new production pools and market pools on NFGDC.
- ❖ **Business Party User Roles Request Form**
- used to arrange for Users of a Business Party to access the Transportation Scheduling System (TSS). Access to TSS is necessary to maintain market pools and place nominations.
- ❖ **Delegation Maintenance Form**
- used to allow one Business Party to operate on behalf of another Business Party.
- ❖ **TSS Liability Waiver Form**
- this waiver of liability form must be signed and returned to Transportation Services before access to TSS will be granted.
- ❖ **Supplier Acknowledgment Form**
- requires Supplier to adhere to NFGDC policies and procedures regarding Citygate Balancing, OFO's, etc.
- ❖ **Meter Read Revision Request Form**
- used by marketers to submit revisions to customer meter reads that are to be used for billing.
- ❖ **Upstream Agency Consent Form**
- used for situations where a Business Party elects to accept released capacity from NFGDC, and wishes to designate a qualified Shipper to act as the Business Party's Agent for the capacity. The NFGDC capacity can then be released to the Agent.
- ❖ **TSS Emergency Forms**
- are used only upon the express written consent of Transportation Services. This set of forms is designed to replicate the processes normally transacted through TSS.

Note: For NFGDC's PA Division, the intended Market Pool Operator must be licensed by the PA PUC in order to act as a Supplier in PA on the NFGDC System. There is currently a filing fee for this license.
