Payment Assistance for PA Residential Customers

Low-Income Home Energy
Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
Up to \$1,000 of federal funding to help pay

Neighbor for Neighbor Heat Fund
Financial help for eligible low-income individuals
or families.

Low-Income Ratepayer Assistance (LIRA)
Reduced-rate monthly bills between 10% and
80% plus debt forgiveness.

Weatherization aid for customers who meet income/consumption requirements.

Customer Assistance Referral and Evaluation Service (CARES)

Payment arrangements and assistance referrals for customers facing hardships.
