The Energy Affordability Program (EAP) provides monthly bill discounts on gas delivery charges ranging from \$1.92-\$34.70. Discounts are subject to change.

Recent tariff changes permit enrollment in the Company's EAP for customers who have received a Federal Home Energy Assistance Program ("HEAP") payment or other qualifying governmental assistance within the past 18 months. Find the list of qualifying programs on the reverse side.

Accounts that are eligible for EAP will also be enrolled in a Budget Plan to help make winter bills more affordable.
